USA BASEBALL ATHLETE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM INFORMATION

Under the direction of Hall of Famer **Tommy Lasorda**, and with **Davidson College head coach and camp director Dick Cooke** on staff, Team USA was winner of the Gold Medal in the 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney, Australia. And now the Davidson Wildcat Baseball Camp is proud to be a charter member in the **USA Baseball Athlete Development Program**. As a participant in the 2002 Davidson Wildcat Baseball Camp you automatically become part of the USA Baseball Athlete Development Program, including identification for USA Baseball National Team Trials and Teams (U14, U16, U18). You will also receive a USA baseball cap as a part of your camp registration.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

Takes place at Wildcat Park on the campus of Davidson College. Once an application is received the camper will be mailed a medical form and a confirmation with detailed registration information and other aspects of camp. Directions to campus and the baseball field will also be included.

CAMP STAFF:

Dick Cooke, Head baseball coach at Davidson College, is the camp director. Cooke, in his 12th year as head coach at Davidson, is the winningest coach in Davidson history and was named conference coach of the year in 1992. He also pitched in the Boston Red Sox organization and served on Tommy Lasorda's coaching staff for Team USA, the gold medal winners in the 2000 Summer Olympics. Cooke also served on the coaching staff for Team USA at the 1999 Pan Am Games.

Other staff members will include: **Davidson College assistants Rick Hurni, Mike McAlpin and Steve Aldrich**; Henry Heil, **Greensboro College assistant**; Jay Matthews, **Colorado Rockies scout**; Hal Bagwell, **South Mecklenburg HS head coach**, Mike Lawson, **Central Davidson HS coach**; Linn Williams, **South Rowan HS head coach**; Chris Pollard, **Pfeiffer University head coach**. Other college and high school coaches will join the staff as well as some of the current Davidson College players.
